NATIONAL GRID: On the morning of Sunday 14th April (2am) a very large load will be delivered to National Grid via our estate. There will be temporary changes made to the gateway which we trust will not cause too much inconvenience.

ESTATE GATES: The estate gates are now on summer opening times which means they will also be open on Sundays.

PARKING: Parking signs will soon be erected to remind EVERYONE working or visiting the estate where they are allowed to park. Also, please do not park and overhang your vehicle from your forecourt into the road.

STADIUM DEVELOPMENT: The haul road from Plough Lane to Riverside Road is now operational and the works traffic operates within a one way system. A second opening onto Riverside Road from the new stadium will open soon. Work to the stadium has been delayed until May/June and is due to complete in June 2020. Roadworks are planned for Plough Lane from June which may narrow the roadway with knock-on effects.

ESTATE WORKS: Riverside Road is likely to have roadworks for a few days whilst UKPN improve their connectivity between Riverside Yard and National Grid.

OTHER INFO: Remember that the high emission vehicle tax is now operational in central London.
